Project Location: APN 204-650-0-01: Located south of Highway 299W and the Shasta CSD boundary. Access to property via Lower Springs Road to Swift Fox to Brickwood Drive. Within Shasta CSD SOI boundary.

Brief Project Description: This project only effects a change in jurisdiction for services to the parcel, which inadvertently is covered by two agencies. This action adjusts the boundaries of both agencies so Shasta CSD will provide water and other services to the parcel. A tentative map is under preparation for future zoning/general plan changes. The parcel must be served by one agency before submission. A biological study was prepared in 2009.

Determination: Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish and G. Code § 711.4(c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee. This determination does not in any way imply that the project is exempt from CEQA and does not determine the significance of any potential project effects evaluated pursuant to CEQA.
