RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION  
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA  
MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING  
A DISTRICT CONSOLIDATION BY MANDATORY RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta, State of California, that

WHEREAS, a proposal for the consolidation of independent fire protection districts in the County of Shasta has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and prepared a report, including her recommendation thereon, the proposal and report having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, this Commission called for and held a public hearing on the proposal on November 3, 1994, and at the hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections, and evidence where were made, presented, or filed, and all persons present were given an opportunity to hear and be heard with respect to this proposal and the report of the Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Commission certifies that the proposal is subject to a Negative Declaration subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follow:

1. The Negative Declaration issued by the Central Valley Fire Protection District and the Summit City Fire Protection District is ratified.
2. Consolidation of the Central Valley Fire Protection District and the Summit City Fire Protection District is approved, subject to the following terms and conditions:
  - (A) The consolidated district shall hereafter be known as the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District.
  - (B) The jurisdictional boundary of the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District shall be coterminous to the existing City of Shasta Lake corporate boundary plus the area lying east of the City of Shasta Lake which is presently within the Central Valley Fire Protection District, as depicted on "Exhibit A" attached hereto.

EXHIBIT b.

- (C) The Sphere of Influence boundary for the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District shall be coterminous to the jurisdictional boundary of said district.
- (D) The following terms and conditions as requested by the governing boards of the consolidating districts shall apply:
  - 1. All assets, liabilities, obligations, service responsibility, and employees will be consolidated.
  - 2. All existing Civil Service rights, seniority rights, retirement rights, and other employee benefits and rights for existing employees will be continued.
  - 3. All taxes, Fire Suppression assessments, and fees presently imposed by the districts will stay at the same rates.
  - 4. A new Board of Directors for the consolidated district will be appointed, of which two will be from the Summit City FPD Board, and five will be from the Central Valley FPD Board. This new Board will serve until the next election, at which time the Board will be reduced to five members.
- (3) The territory subject to the district consolidation, as depicted on "Exhibit A", contains approximately 6,500 acres, and is assigned the following distinctive short-form designation: Consolidation: Central Valley FPD/Summit City FPD.
- (4) The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta is designated as the Conducting Authority, and the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta is hereby authorized to conduct subsequent proceedings in compliance with this resolution.
- (5) The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail copies of this resolution as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code.

thence running north along the westerly section line of section 28 a distance of 2668.07 feet to the east 1/4 corner of said section 28;

thence N. 89° 18' 21" E., a distance of 2642.74 feet to the center of said section 28;

thence S. 0° 23' 51" E., a distance of 2364.99 feet to the center of section 5, T.32N., R.4W.;



**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
ORDERING A DISTRICT CONSOLIDATION**

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta adopted Resolution No. 94-08 on November 3, 1994 making determinations and approving the consolidation of the Central Valley Fire Protection District and the Summit City Fire Protection District into one fire protection district as depicted on and described in Exhibits A & B attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of district consolidation as approved by the Local Agency Formation Commission are as follows:

- (A) The consolidated district shall hereafter be known as the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District.
- (B) The jurisdictional boundary of the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District shall be coterminous to the existing City of Shasta Lake corporate boundary plus the area lying east of the City of Shasta Lake which is presently within the Central Valley Fire Protection District, as depicted on "Exhibit A" attached hereto.
- (C) The Sphere of Influence boundary for the Shasta Lake Fire Protection District shall be coterminous to the jurisdictional boundary of said district.
- (D) The following terms and conditions as requested by the governing boards of the consolidating districts shall apply:
  - 1. All assets, liabilities, obligations, service responsibility, and employees will be consolidated.
  - 2. All existing Civil Service rights, seniority rights, retirement rights, and other employee benefits and rights for existing employees will be continued.
  - 3. All taxes, Fire Suppression assessments, and fees presently imposed by the districts will stay at the same rates.
  - 4. A new Board of Directors for the consolidated district will be appointed, of which two will be from the Summit City FPD Board, and five will be from the Central Valley FPD Board. This new Board will serve until the next election, at which time the Board will be reduced to five members;

and,

WHEREAS, the reason for the district consolidation is to provide consistency and equality in the delivery of fire protection services in the area; and,

WHEREAS, the regular County assessment roll was utilized by this Board; and,

WHEREAS, the affected territory will not be taxed for existing general bonded indebtedness of the County as a product of this consolidation; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this consolidation was called for and held by this Board at the place and time noticed therefore on December 6, 1994, and this Board finds and determines that the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn is less than 25 percent of the registered voters residing within the territory subject to district consolidation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta hereby orders that the Central Valley Fire Protection District and the Summit City Fire Protection District be consolidated into one district, and the Clerk of the Board is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution with applicable fees required by Section 54902.5 of the Government Code to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Shasta County.
