**SUBJECT:** City of Shasta Lake Sphere of Influence


Dear Georgia:

At their meeting on June 2, 1994, the Commission adopted a resolution establishing a coterminous sphere of influence for the City of Shasta Lake. This is to transmit for your records a copy of the Commission's resolution, together with a map depicting the approved sphere boundary.

Please be advised that Section 56428 of the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985 (LAFCo Law) provides that any person or local agency may file a written request for sphere of influence amendment, subject to the provisions with respect to notice, hearing, continuance, and reimbursement as set forth under the section. For your information, I am enclosing a copy of Section 56428.

A copy of the resolution will also be transmitted to each affected agency and to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. I am also providing a copy of this resolution and map and Section 56428 to City Planning Director Joe Hunter, together with other materials he has requested.

Resolution No. 94-04  
RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION  
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA  
ESTABLISHING A COTERMINOUS SPHERE OF INFLUENCE  
FOR THE CITY OF SHASTA LAKE

WHEREAS, Section 56425 et seq of the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985 includes the following:

"In order to carry out its purposes and responsibilities for planning and shaping the logical and orderly development and coordination of local governmental agencies so as to advantageously provide for the present and future needs of the county and its communities, the Local Agency Formation Commission shall develop and determine the sphere of influence of each local governmental agency within the county.";

WHEREAS, Section 56425 et seq further states: "In determining the sphere of influence for each local agency the Commission shall consider and prepare a written statement of its determinations with respect to each of the following:

- "(1) The present and planned land uses in the area, including agricultural and open-space lands.
- "(2) The present and probable need for public facilities and services in the area.
- "(3) The present capacity of public facilities and adequacy of public services which the agency provides or is authorized to provide.
- "(4) The existence of any social or economic communities of interest in the area if the commission determines that they are relevant to the agency.";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 56425 et seq, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta has developed and determined a Sphere of Influence for the City of Shasta Lake, in the course of this activity having determined and made the following findings:

The Sphere of Influence boundary for the City of Shasta Lake shall be coterminous to the existing corporate boundary of the City of Shasta Lake, therefore:

- (1) The present and planned land uses in the sphere of influence area are consistent with the present and planned land uses in the City of Shasta Lake.
- (2) There is either a present need or there will be a probable need in the sphere of influence area for the broad range of public facilities and services that can be provided by the City of Shasta Lake.
- (3) The City of Shasta Lake has the present capacity of public facilities and adequacy of public services to meet the services needs of the area in the sphere of influence.

- (4) The area within the coterminous sphere of influence boundary displays a social and economic interdependence on and interrelationship with the City of Shasta Lake.

**WHEREAS**, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta, pursuant to Section 56427, conducted a public hearing called and held for the purpose of considering for adoption a sphere of influence for the City of Shasta Lake;

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, it has been determined that adoption of a Sphere of Influence for the City of Shasta Lake will not have a substantial impact upon the environment and that a Negative Declaration is justified, said Negative Declaration having been prepared by the City of Shasta Lake as Lead Agency for environmental review, said Negative Declaration having been filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta does hereby ratify the Negative Declaration prepared by the City of Shasta Lake and adopt a Sphere of Influence for the City of Shasta Lake which is coterminous to the existing City of Shasta Lake corporate boundary, as shown on the attached map marked "Exhibit A":

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution and "Exhibit A" shall be transmitted to the City of Shasta Lake, to each affected agency, and to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta.

**DULY PASSED AND ADOPTED** this 2nd day of June, 1994 by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Shasta, State of California by the following vote:


