Meters are read on the working day nearest the end of the month with an allowance of 4 days each way to adjust for Sundays, Holidays and unusual conditions. EACH INSTALLED METER WILL BE CHARGED THE MINIMUM RATE, WHETHER OR NOT WATER IS USED, OR THE HOUSE IS OCCUPIED OR VACANT. In the case of rentals, the landowner is responsible for the service charge.

Bills are due and payable at the District office upon receipt. A penalty of ten percent (10%) will be charged by the District if the bill is not paid by the due date as indicated on the bill. A delinquent notice (Second Notice) will be sent if the bill has not been paid by the due date. This allows the customer another 5-7 days in which to pay their bill. At the end of that time period, a third notice (Cut Off Letter) will be sent which is a discontinuance of service letter, which states that customer service will be terminated if the delinquent bill is not paid by the date designated in the letter. If the District receives no response following the third notice (Cut Off Letter), District personnel will deliver a Final Disconnection Notice in which the customer will have 24 hours to contact the office to make arrangements for payment. According to Resolution 94-2 adopted by the Board of Directors on January 27, 1994, with an effective date of February 1, 1994, there will be a \$15.00 charge for the delivery of the Final Disconnection Notice. If the Final Disconnection Notice is enforced and service discontinued, there will be a \$40.00 charge for reconnection of service.

TENANTS / BROKERS: Upon applying for water service from the District, tenants shall deposit with the District the sum of \$100.00 or secure the landowner's signature of responsibility on a form provided by the District. The deposit is refundable upon payment of the closing bill provided the tenant notifies the District on or before the date he terminates his occupancy of the property and presents his deposit receipt. If the deposit is not claimed within ninety (90) days, it will be forfeited to the District.

A complete copy of the rules and regulations of the District is on file and available for inspection at the District office during business hours.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

For your convenience in paying water bills, the District has a locked drop box in the parking lot. Your payment can be deposited 24 hours a day.

The Muletown Conduit from the Whiskeytown Lake Reservoir transmits your source of water.

FIRE AND MEDICAL EMERGENCY: Centerville Volunteer Fire Company will respond in any emergency when you call 911. By calling 911, and stating your emergency, trained volunteers will be dispatched immediately. DO NOT CALL the Centerville Fire Company.

GARBAGE SERVICE: Garbage pick up is made by the Waste Management of Anderson Cottonwood Disposal. Phone 221-4784 to arrange for this service.

BEING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 96-1
AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF
CENTERVILLE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AMENDING THE DROUGHT SURCHARGE FEE


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Centerville Community Services District as follows:

“Section 7(e) Drought Surcharge: The Board of Directors of the Centerville Community Services District has declared a Drought Emergency by Resolution 2014-03. Therefore, based on July 2013 water usage, each installed service shall be charged an annual Drought Surcharge to be billed monthly beginning May 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015.
