Dear Dave:

The Shasta Community Services District (CSD) requested that Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC) perform an income survey of the Shasta CSD residents in Shasta, California. The purpose of this survey is to establish a median household income (MHI) level to optimize their funding and resources options. This survey has been completed and the results are attached (see Chart 1, page 2).

The MHI for Shasta CSD is \$48,900 with a response rate of 40 percent.

Shasta Community Services District has 812 parcels; 57 parcels are vacant homes; six (6) parcels are vacation homes; nine (9) parcels are commercial; leaving 740 parcels (households) to survey. The number of households in a range between 651-1200 requires a sample size of 25 percent to meet State and Federal guidelines.

The survey was designed and conducted per State and Federal guidelines established for USDA Rural Development, Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund, and California Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund. The California statewide MHI is determined to be \$62,883. Intermediate is determined to be at 80 percent of the statewide MHI (80% of \$62,883 = \$50,307), and poverty is determined to be less than \$50,306 with violation.
