All that portion of Section 26, Township 35 North, Range 5 West, MDB&M, described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 19, Shasta Lake Subdivision, Unit No. 1 as per plat on file in Book 8 of Maps at Page 4, Shasta County Records, said point being North $89^{\circ}10'30''$ west 952.93 feet; thence, north $51^{\circ}23'15''$ west 66.89 feet from the east 1/4 corner of said Section 26; thence, along the boundary of said subdivision south $51^{\circ}23'15''$ east 233.49 feet; thence, south $23^{\circ}17'30''$ west 295.75 feet; thence, south $60^{\circ}45'15''$ west 348.53 feet; thence, south $0^{\circ}55'$ west 265.98 feet; thence, leaving said boundary south $0^{\circ}55'$ west 288.53 feet; thence, south $42^{\circ}18'30''$ west 185.3 feet; thence, north $56^{\circ}31'15''$ west 263.9 feet to the northeasterly corner of Shasta Lake Subdivision, Unit No. 4 as per plat on file in Book 10 of Maps at Page 20, Shasta County Records; thence, along last said boundary south $7^{\circ}11'$ west 373.40 feet; thence, south $79^{\circ}13'30''$ west 163.73 feet to a 6"x6" concrete monument as shown on the map on file in Book 23 of Land Surveys at Page 51, Shasta County Records; thence, along the following courses as shown on said survey south $79^{\circ}13'30''$ west 122.31 feet; thence, south $25^{\circ}11'45''$ east 280.35 feet; thence, west 817.87 feet to the midsection line of said Section 26; thence, along said midsection line north $1^{\circ}57'34''$ east 2611 feet more or less to the northwest corner of Parcel Two conveyed in the deed recorded in Book 1009 of Official Records at Page 327, Shasta County Records; thence along the boundary of said property north $89^{\circ}43'47''$ east 989.72 feet; thence, south $18^{\circ}37'32''$ west 204.88 feet; thence, north $77^{\circ}00'47''$ east 176.38 feet; thence leaving said boundary north $77^{\circ}00'47''$ east 241.45 feet more or less to the northeast corner of Parcel One conveyed in said Deed; thence, along the boundary of said Parcel One south $40^{\circ}23'28''$ east 73.10 feet to the northeast corner of Shasta Lake Subdivision, Unit 2 as per the Plat on file in Book 8 of Maps at Page 14, Shasta County Records; thence, along the boundary of said Unit 2 south $40^{\circ}23'28''$ east 336.50 feet; thence, south $9^{\circ}45'17''$ west 480.45 feet to the true point of beginning, containing 80 acres more or less.





PLATE 6
